

# Intel-Powered Classmate PC Quick Guide:

## Parents Carefree Monitoring Software\*



Parents Carefree enables you to monitor and control what your child does on his or her PC. You can limit use of the PC to certain times. You can also limit when and if they can access specific Web sites and programs. And you can monitor the programs, files, and network locations they access, and even take screen shots of their activities.

- Once installed, the “green P” **Parents Carefree** icon displays on the taskbar in lower right corner of the screen. Right-click on that icon to display menu options (fig. 1).
- Select **Setting**. When asked for a Password, click OK or press Enter. The Configuration Center screen is displayed (fig. 2).

## There are five major configuration areas:

- **Network Filter:**  
Specify Web sites that can and cannot be visited.
- **Program Control:**  
Specify programs that cannot be run.
- **Time Scheduling:**  
Specify when the computer must be off, when network access is allowed, when Network Filters are in effect, and when Program Control is in effect.
- **Log Setting:**  
Turn network, program, disk, and screen snapshots on or off and specify the maximum size of the log file. Review logged data to monitor your child's PC usage.
- **Other Settings:**  
Set Parent password, set a Hotkey to run the Configuration Center, and hide the Parents Carefree icon from the taskbar.

## Getting Started:

1. Select **Basic Setting**. Create a password so that your child cannot change your settings.
2. Select **Log Review**. Become familiar with the four log types.
3. Select each setting to learn what it can do. Over time, decide if and how to limit your child's use of the PC. Limit usage by Web site, time, network access, or program.
4. When finished, set mode back to Children (see fig. 1).
